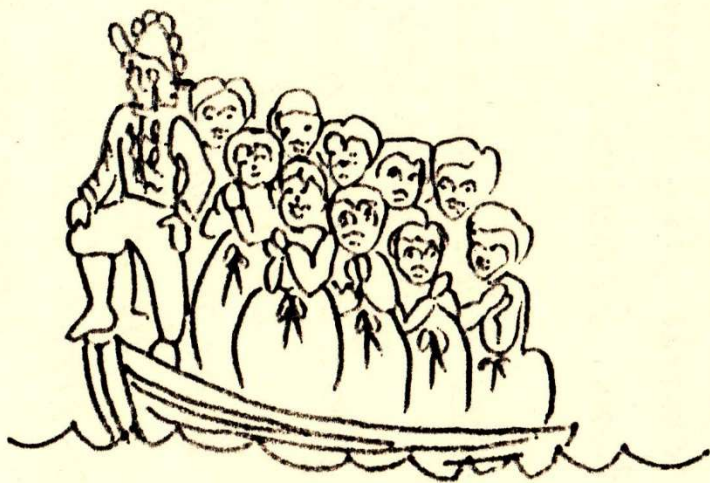

The Austin Gilbert & Sullivan Society began with an informal meeting at the Creek Theatre in September, 1976. Encouraged by the public's reception of ZSTC's H.M.S. Pinafore, April, 1976, the group decided to form a local society to share enjoyment of the G&S operas through periodic performances and regular meetings. A very successful Rudigore was staged at the Creek Theatre in February, 1977.

In November, 1977, the centenary of Gilbert and Sullivan's rarely-performed Sorcerer was celebrated with an extremely well-received production at Hancock Center's Town Hall.

The Society associated with ZSTC for Pirates of Penzance, 1977, and The Mikado, 1978, then in December, 1978, produced Iolanthe in cooperation with St. Edwards. Future plans include a joint production with ZSTC in Spring, 1980.

We meet on the first Monday of every month. Dues are \$5.00 yearly, entitling members to a monthly newsletter and discount admission to G&S performances.
